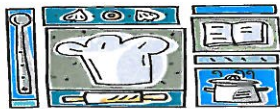

Day 3 – Saturday, July 20, 2013

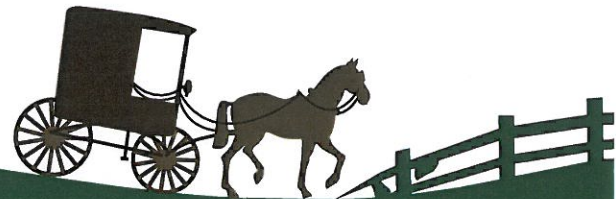
Amish Country Touring, Cook's Bison Ranch
