Nestled in the Northern corner of the Niagara Region and just beyond Niagara Falls, is the picturesque town of **Niagara-on-the-Lake** that **epitomizes old town charm**. The Victorian village is bordered on both sides by waterfronts with arbor-framed streets and lush boulevard gardens. Enjoy free time to explore the quaint shops, boutiques and have lunch at one of the many street side cafes or fine restaurants in the area. Later, we board a **Niagara Jet Boat Ride** an invigorating adventure on the Niagara River to **Whirlpool Rapids**. Our final visit today will be a **Ice Winery Tour** to learn about the in-depth process of creating ice wine and an opportunity to taste this delectable table wine and cordial. We return to our hotel with the balance of the day free to enjoy the shopping and variety of ethnic restaurants to please everyone's tastes! **(B)**
