Day 3 Monday, July 12, 2027 – Denali National Park, Tundra Tour

Breakfast will be included this morning. Today, travel deep into Denali National Park aboard the **Tundra Wilderness Bus Tour** and keep your eyes open for bears, moose, caribou, Dall sheep, as well as others. This tour is narrated to allow for unique insight into this amazing region. A box lunch is included on board. There will be time for optional tours today.

Day 4 Tuesday, July 13, 2027 – Fairbanks, Alaska, University of Fairbanks, Gold Dredge # 8

Breakfast will be included today. This morning, we travel to the University of Fairbanks to visit the **Museum of the North** that offers a comprehensive blend of natural history, cultural heritage and Arctic research to the visitor. Next, visit the university's experiment farm and **Jorgenson Gardens** for an overview of Alaska's agricultural research program. This afternoon, enjoy the **Gold Dredge #8** Tour where you will ride the Tanana Valley Railroad through the gold field of the Interior. Meet Alaskan miners who will explain the history of mining in Alaska and get a chance to pan for gold.

Day 5 Wednesday, July 14, 2027 – Fairbanks City Tour - Alaska Pipeline – Riverboat Discovery Cruise – Athabaskan Village

Breakfast will be included this morning. Today, enjoy a city tour of Fairbanks featuring the **Morris Thompson Center** as well as the **Trans-Alaska Pipeline**. This afternoon, cruise the Chena River aboard the **Riverboat Discovery Cruise** and visit a recreated **Athabaskan Village**. This evening, enjoy an Alaskan style dinner!

Day 6 Thursday, July 15, 2027 – Delta Junction – Farm Tour

Breakfast will be included this morning before we travel south to **Delta Junction, Alaska**. Upon arrival we'll visit a local farmstead for an update on the farming practices required to raise livestock and crops in this area of Alaska. There will also be time to explore Delta Junction on your own. Later this afternoon we return to Fairbanks with the balance of the evening free.

Day 7 Friday, July 16, 2027 – Wrangel St Elias Visitor Center – Valdez, Alaska

Breakfast will be included this morning. We depart Fairbanks and travel South on the scenic Richardson Highway through several mountain ranges. Along the way we will visit the **Wrangel St Elias Visitor Center** located in the largest national park in the United States. The campus-like setting includes: a visitor center, a park store, an exhibit hall, a theater, restrooms, picnic tables, an amphitheater, the Ahtna Cultural Center, scenic overlooks and short hiking trails. We then continue south to the port town of Valdez.

Day 8 Saturday, July 17, 2027 – Prince William Sound - Glacier Cruise - Valdez

Breakfast will be included this morning. Today, we travel into **Prince William Sound** on the **Columbia Glacier Cruise**.

Explore the face of a glacier and be on the lookout for whales, sea lions, otters, and more. Lunch will be included on board. The balance of the day is free to explore **Valdez** (on our own). This evening a dinner is planned.
